## **RiverHawks Bring Youth Development Program to Coeur d'Alene**

**Spokane, WA** (February 25, 2010) – As a way to bring more programs to a growing list of interested young athletes in Northern Idaho, the RiverHawks are expanding the recently launched Youth Development Programs to include camps and clinics in Coeur d'Alene.

Both camps will take place when schools are out for Spring Break. They will be led by Nick Rook, who was named Idaho Coach of the Year last year after leading the Vikings to the state tournament in his first year as head coach at Coeur d'Alene High School. The camps are \$50 each for early registration, and \$60 thereafter.
